INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT TO THE TRUSTEES

I report on the accounts of Kingston Society for Children and Adults with Learning Disabilities for the year ended 31st December 2014, which are set out on pages 2 to 5

 - to prepare accounts which accord with the accounting records and comply with the accounting requirements of the 2011 Act

2. to which, in my opinion, attention should be drawn in order to enable a proper understanding of the accounts to be reached.
