New Plan to make services for adults with autism and their families better

We are writing to you to let you know about an important new plan in Kingston to improve services and support for adults with autism spectrum conditions (ASC) including Asperger syndrome.

This Plan is about supporting people with autism to have a better life and we need your help to make sure its right.

The plan sets out how we will make services work better in four main areas:

- 1. Making it easier for people to find out if they have autism and so get the support they need
- 2. Teaching more people such as social workers, doctors and support workers about autism so they can offer the right support to people
- 3. Helping young people with autism move into Adult Social Care Services in an easy and helpful way
- 4. Having a senior manager to lead the planning of services for people with autism backed up by a Board which will include people with autism and their families.
