Those of you who have seen the building have been pleasantly surprised at how it now looks. We are now almost fully booked in the evenings and actively working on more daytime and weekend lettings. To date, all our lettings have been to local charities or members, making it a proper Community Centre. Michelle Kitch has taken over as our Administrator and she has already contacted many of you regarding Annual Subscriptions and the new General Data Protection Regulations coming into force on May 25th. If you do not give your consent for Kingston Mencap to keep information about you on our database please inform us and we will remove your details. Michelle has also been building links with other organisations who work with people with learning disabilities, and we are exploring ways in which we can work together.

Seekers Club

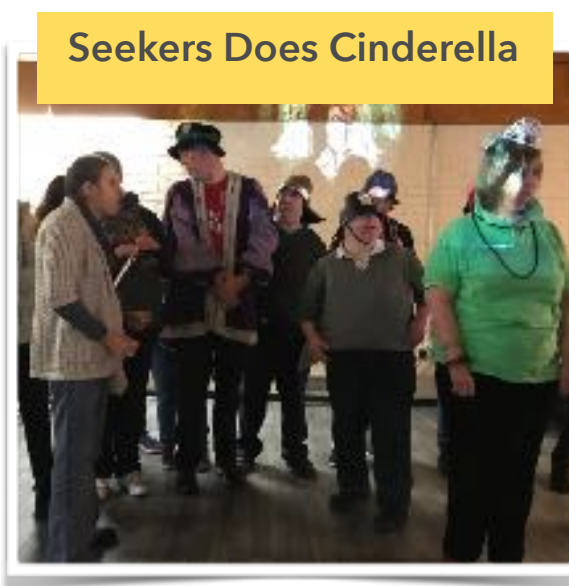
