Time: 10 am - 12.00 midday. Cost: Free



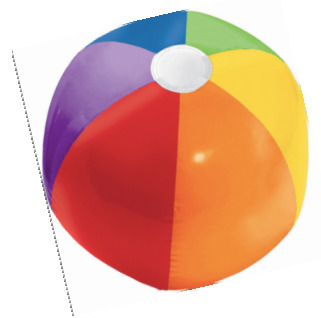
Tuesday 30th April
